PLAYOFF TIE-BREAKING RULES

2 teams tied start at rule #1

3 or more start at Rule #2

- 1) Most points in games between the 2 tied teams in playoffs.
- 2) Most wins in all playoff games
- 3) GF % (GF / GF + GA) higher % advances.

Goals for against only in playoff games will apply for this tie-breaker

IE: teams score 10 goals and gives up 10 goals. 10/20 = .5

- 4) Fewest goals against in all playoff games
- 5) Team the scored the earliest goal in playoffs.

Note: if 3 or 4 teams are tied and after a tie-breaker it only advances one team That team will advance.

the remaining 2 or 3 will go onto the next tie-breaker.

There is no reverting back.

SUPER SUNDAY

If the game is tied at the end of regualtion play Teams will play a 10 minute overtime period

Teams will play 3 on 3 hockey in OT

First team to score wins

If still tied after the 10 min OT there will be a shootout

Each team will select 3 players.

If tied after the 3 shooters the teams will select 1 shooter each.

Note: It must be a different player every time. A player cannot shoot twice

This will continue on until 1 team scores and the other does not

Penalties during 3 on 3 play

Should 1 team receive a penalty the non offending team will add a player It will be 4 on 3 hockey.

Once the penalty expires teams will play 4 on 4 until the next stoppage then revert back to 3 on 3.
