COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Entering the Arenas

- Please arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before your game time.
- Each individual participant and spectator (including all children) will be required to complete the following online Covid-19 Screening Form once per day.

- There will be a City Recreational Facility Screener at each arena. In order to be permitted into the arena you will be required to show the following three documents to them.
 - Completed online Covid-19 screening form that displays "You may enter the building". For example:

YOU MAY ENTER THE BUILDING

Tom Graham Arena - Wednesday February 2nd 2022 5:13 PM

Note that this can be completed prior to your arrival at the arena; just take a screen shot to show the screener.

- Proof of Covid-19 vaccination ONLY the enhanced vaccine certificate
 with the official QR code will be accepted as proof. The certificate can be
 stored on your phone as a PDF or it can be a printed copy; whichever
 format you have MUST show the QR code. This is not a requirement for
 children under 12.
- Valid Identification (ID)

We are not placing specific restrictions on who can attend the tournament.

While in the Arenas

Masks and Social Distancing

Masks are required to be worn properly (covering nose, mouth, and chin) at all
times while in the arenas. While in the change room hockey players are required
to wear masks until they are ready to leave the change room to go on the ice. At
that time they can remove their mask and put on their helmet. Upon returning to
the change room players are required to immediately remove their helmet and
put on their mask.

Remember: Mask off, helmet on. Helmet off, mask on.

 Please social distance whenever possible while in the arenas including in the change room.

Food and Drinks

- The snack bars will not be open.
- We respectfully request that you minimize the consumption of food and drinks while in the arenas.

Photographer

 We have been authorized to have a game photographer on site at the Ed Sackfield Arena. They will be setting up in a manner to permit social distancing. Please do your part to support social distancing. You may be required to line up and wait your turn to view the photos on the screens. If lines get too long, arena or tournament staff may need to ask you to leave and return at a less busy time.

Tournaments are fun but can also be a stressful time. Please respect our staff's requests and instructions. The success of this tournament, in terms of respecting Covid-19 protocols, will impact RHHA's ability to run future tournaments this season.
